Jnwanted lights can be dropped off in the same way as the trees. "There is a box outside the admission gate for the lights," Wiley said. "People can simply drive up, drop off and drive away. Holiday lights dropped off will be collected and forwarded to a recycler where their parts will be separated, allowing 100 percent of each light unit turned in to be recycled. Rope lights, garland lights, C7, C9, mini lights and LED holiday lights are all accepted. Yard light displays can be accepted as long as they contain electric wiring and can be broken down to lay flat for storage and transportation The zoo will accept the lights and trees through Jan. 15.
