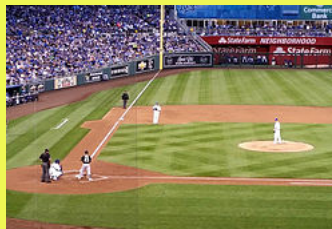

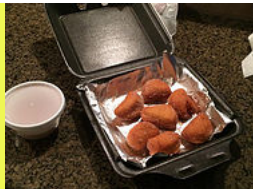
Mundane Monday: Ryan finally made me take a Monday off to hang out! I miss my Mundane Monday! Thank goodness, they are back!
